

Criteria for Evaluation of OMR

The procedure to evaluate the OMR used by candidates is as under

1. In normal case a candidate have to select three subject by darken the bubble and attempted the questions. All attempted subject will be evaluated.

In case :-

If attempted the questions without darken the bubble of the subjects but subjects are up to three. All attempted subject will be evaluated.

If attempted subjects are more than three and subject bubbles are darken. The first three subjects will be evaluated.

If attempted subjects are more than three and none of the subject bubbles is darken. The first three subjects will be evaluated.

If attempted subjects are more than three and bubbles of some of the subject are darken. The selected subjects will be evaluated first and remaining (three minus bubbled subject) subjects among un darken subjects will evaluated from the top.

If subject bubble is darken and none of the question is attempted. This will be considered as an attempted subject. However, even if a single question is attempted this will be treated as attempted subject

If subject bubble is not darken and even a single question is attempted the subject will be evaluated as per above conditions.
